This is my Drawing Workshop proposal targeted for teens.

Many teen patrons will love these workshops. I have notice from doing these workshops for the past 10 years, 8 out of 10 teens who read and love Manga books are inspired artists.

They love to draw or want to learn, to improve their skills and in search for guidance and my expertise.

We have many programs that will guarantee to peak your teens interests in participating.

Meet the Artist of Night and Day Anime!

This is a power point presentation to show what we are about, and the process of becoming a comic book artist and writer. Teen patrons can come to meet us and show us their artwork/ portfolio. We will give them tips, answer, and any questions they may have in a Q&A session if they are looking to join the art industry during the second half of the program. We will show our comics that we self-published, even raffle off a few posters and a Night and Day Anime Studio Promo pack, which includes 4 books and one poster. (We will also bring more autographed posters and books to sell with Library's permission of course.)

1 hr. art session; cost for this program: \$150. Convention panel - price may vary.



- 1. Learn How to Draw Anime
- 2. Learn How to Draw Pokémon
- 3. Learn to Design Game Characters

This details on a quick but easy step by step drawing art class on how to draw anime characters, usually a regular Anime boy or girl, or hero and villain. Pretty basic, we offer guidance on how draw simple cartoons.

\$150. (10 to 15 teens) \$225 (15 - 20 teens).

Workshop includes materials (pencils, markers, erasers and paper) and handout tutorials.



Learn How to Draw Chibi Workshop

Chibi is a Japanese slang word meaning "short person" or "small child". It is frequently used in Anime and Manga. It's more of a cartoon like course with a cute side to it all. A lot of preteens and teen girls love this workshop.

90 min. art session; cost for this program: \$150. (10 to 15 teens) \$225 (15 - 20 teens).

Workshop includes materials (pencils, markers, erasers and paper) and handout tutorials.



Since the Marvel and DC movies have become very popular, many teens strive to become comic book artists. This workshop has been developed to offer tips and solid tools they will need to improve their artistic skills of comic drawing. We will teach the teens how to draw characters like Ironman, Hulk, Superman with simple structure of shapes and line work.

90 min. art session; cost for this program: \$150. (10 to 15 teens) \$225 (15 - 20 teens).

Draw Your Own Anime T-Shirt Workshop

The teens can draw popular or original character art work. We will take the drawings and transfer them on to t-shirts. Teens must provide the white shirts. Graphic work will be done after the artwork has been scanned and if the teens want, text or names can be added to their drawing for their t-shirt design.

(10 to 12 teens ONLY)

90 min. art session. Program cost \$300.

\$150 for the workshop and \$150 for the materials, transfers and labor. Allow 7 to 10 days for finalization, and we will drop them off at your library for pick up.

We also do **Mouse pads** as well.

They will have their very own personalized T-shirt or mouse pad with their artwork. And just in case they are not motivated or have no artwork to submit, we will provide pre-set artwork where they can look through our portfolio and pick something out. Workshop includes materials (pencils, markers, erasers and paper) and handout tutorials.



Learn How to Draw Your Own Comic Book Character

This workshop is a discussion and drawing workshop. I will look at the teen patron's drawings and offer tips; hear out their ideas of storyline, and help to polish their work. Give them tips and the solid tools they will need to get to that next level in creating a story to reach their target audience. This usually takes a bit of commitment, due to that fact that we have to do a lot of one on one discussions with people. At least 3 classes.



First class: Intro; Group session discussion about their stories, get feedback from the group etc...; & Learn How to Draw Faces (boy and girl examples).

Second class: Learn How to Draw Anatomy; Simple human sketches with guidance on how to refine their anatomy skills.

Third class: Learn How to do Character Designs. Reference materials and storylines will be offered. It's an extreme workshop and always seems to do well. Classes could be a week apart, which I recommend. Or one class a month. It's up to you.

2 hr. sessions each.

Workshop includes materials (pencils, markers, erasers and paper) and handout tutorials.

\$150 (10 to 15 teens) each workshop. \$450. \$200 (15 to 25 teens) each workshop. \$600.

Comic Book Workshop

This is a GREAT and successful

workshop, especially for families when they can see their kid's accomplish such a wonderful project that is greatly in-depth. We will provide the students with the solid tools they will need to achieve that next level. This will be a five week workshop. (5) workshops-each participant will learn the tools creating an comic of (4) pages with their own original stories and will be placed into one book. Black and white ONLY.

(1) Art Reception w/ prints of the comic after the completion of the work. Each participant will receive copy. They can bring their friends and family to show off their artwork. We will supply all the refreshments, utensils, table cloths and appropriate music CD to listen during reception. Library may want to provide is coffee, hot water for tea and hot chocolate for guests on the day of the Art Reception.

\$150 each workshop. You can always spread it out to two workshops a month to give the teens time to do their assignments or to fit your budget. Or every week or every other week. I will leave that decision to your discretion. lol. Most of the payments would go to comic book prints, tutorial copies, materials, supplies, reference materials and refreshments in order to provide the patrons with the utmost high quality workshop. I also need an projector for power point presentations.

This workshop will impress parents as they see their childrens accomplishments.

The workshop will focus on how to:

- Uncover the components of a good graphic novel
- Be creative in a way that works best for you
- Find your own artistic style Regardless of artistic ability
- Create characters that get and hold people's attention
- Develop a great plot-line and write believable dialogue
- Lay out your pages to keep the story moving forward
- Keep those creative juices flowing when you get stuck
- Get your story published-(Art Reception)

2 hr. sessions each. Workshop includes a power point presentation and handouts, material list, and drawing tutorials.

Program cost: \$150 (10 to 12 teens) each workshop.
